The **Board Member** will provide support to other board members and will participate in coordinating the different activities of the organization. The specific responsibilities of the Board Member will be determined depending on the needed assistance for the different tasks undertaken by the ISPRS SC Board. A diverse set of skills is desired.

In preparing the application, the use of the provided template is required. The application should contain the following information:

- Name, year of birth, city and country of residence, e-mail address(es), current place of employment or educational institution, degree towards you are studying (if applicable).
- Curriculum Vitae (one page).
- Participation during the period 2013-2018 in ISPRS SC activities or other regional and national student activities (0.5 page).
- What are your professional and/or study plans for the period of Jan 2019 to 2020?
- Motivation to become an ISPRS SC board member (0.5 page).
- How you do plan on contributing to the ISPRS SC if elected as a board member? (0.5 page)

Please note:

- **Submission of all required information above is a prerequisite for acceptance of an application by the nomination committee.**
- Active participation in the ISPRS SC activities in the period 2013-2018, at a global, regional or national level or any other student related organisation is considered an asset but not a requirement.
- If a candidate is enrolled as a student and/or is working towards a degree at an educational institution, there is no set age limit. However, in any other circumstances, the age cut off for candidates is 35.
- The expected time commitment for the current vacant positions is 1 year and 6 months. The term will end on the ISPRS Congress 2020, but board members are expected to take part in the transition of documents, responsibilities and other important matters to the newly elected officers for the term 2020 - 2024.
